ea Verneuille designed this cottage for a couple who wanted to downsize and have less yard to maintain. The bungalow style of the exterior board and batten fits comfortably with nearby homes in one of Fairhope's oldest areas. The wide glassed entrance extending from front to back is reminiscent of the historic southern dog-trot. The entry porch and open floor plan places living areas on the front of the home close to the street. The interior is accented with lightly washed cypress boards applied horizontally, a custom patterned stair rail, and antique pine floors. A unique potting and tool shed are the focal point of the rear patio and courtyard.

The home's location along Lakewood's Azalea
Ridge Golf course includes an exterior palette of painted brick walls, slate roof with copper accents, decorative iron brackets, and a monumental entry door. The house is arranged around a private pool court flanked by a greenhouse and matching garden shop. The interior is a refined but com-
